# Introductory Note to this Guide to the use of the Calendar and Lectionary during 2007/08

Each week of the Church's year is identified by its calendar name (e.g. Week of 1 Advent). After the name is given the order of Daily Prayer which is normally to be used during that week. Next is listed the name of the Sunday, with its calendar date, its category in the Calendar, and its liturgical colour.

Also listed are the Feast Days (in categories 1 - 5 of the Calendar) which occur in that week. The order of Daily Prayer which should be used on these days is indicated, and also the liturgical colour.

During 2008 the following Feast Days fall on a Sunday of a higher category and are transferred to the next available weekday:

Kentigern, Bishop	(13 January)
*Peter, Apostle or Peter and Paul, Apostles	(29 June)
*Bartholomew, Apostle	(24 August)
Holy Cross Day	(14 September)
*Matthew, Apostle and Evangelist	(21 September)
All Souls' Day	(2 November)
*Margaret of Scotland	(16 November)
Andrew, Apostle, Patron of Scotland	(30 November)
Thomas, Apostle	(21 December - if not 3 July)
The Holy Innocents	(28 December)

Of these, the four marked with an asterisk may be celebrated on the Sunday if local circumstances require. See the section of the *Calendar and Lectionary* entitled Using the Calendar, notes (iii) and (iv).

The Feast of the Presentation of the Lord [Candlemas] (2 February) may be observed on the preceding Sunday and the Feast of the Ascension (1 May) may be observed on the following Sunday. See the section of the *Calendar and Lectionary* entitled Using the Calendar, notes (i) and (ii).

The Annunciation of the Lord (25 March) falling in Easter Week is transferred to the Monday after the Second Sunday of Easter (31 March). Patrick, Bishop (17 March) and Joseph of Nazareth (19 March) falling in Holy Week are transferred respectively to the Tuesday and Wednesday after the Second Sunday of Easter (1 April & 2 April). Philip and James, Apostles (1 May) falling on Ascension Day is transferred to Friday 2 May.

Optional feasts (category 6) are not included in this Guide. Users should check with the Calendar each week to determine which if any of these feasts they wish to observe. For further guidance see the Introduction to the *Calendar and Lectionary*.
